 - a) Board Meeting Update
 - (1) Berkley District packed meeting, typically 1 or 2 comments. There were 10 on Monday.
 - (2) Email from Superintendent Francis to district familiesrecommend reading this if you haven't yet
 - (3) Superintendent focused on this being an annual process not a new one
 - (a) Angell potential class reduction.
 - (b) Not happening across district just one grade and not all schools
 - (c) Avg in district is 22 per class, some of lowest in state
 - (d) Not a retaliation to teachers
 - (4) Funding clarification what can and can't be used for salary. Millage and bond can't be used for salary
 - (5) 10 community comments, concerns for children, for the district, and teachers. Concerns for students post-pandemic learning.
